Additional Conditions:-

- 1 This certificate is only applicable to the structural stability and civil safety of school buildings/classrooms covered under this. The provisions contained in Circular No. GEDN-M1/188/2025-G.EDN dated 13.05.2026 and Clarification No. GEDN-M1/188/2025-G.EDN dated 25.05.2026, as amended from time to time, shall be strictly complied with by the School Authority. Separate certificates, approvals, or clearances from the competent authorities, wherever required, shall be obtained and maintained by the institution.
- 2 The School Authority shall ensure that all classrooms, offices and other spaces used by students and staff are maintained in a clean, hygienic and safe condition at all times.
- 3 The School Authority shall ensure periodic inspection, maintenance and upkeep of the school premises. Bushes, weeds, and overgrown vegetation shall be cleared regularly to prevent the presence of reptiles, insects and other harmful creatures. The School Safety Monitoring Committee as per Government instructions shall conduct regular inspections and ensure compliance with all safety measures, guidelines and directions issued by the Government and competent authorities from time to time.
- 4 Any tree, branch, structure or other object that may pose a risk to the safety of students, staff, or visitors shall be identified and removed, trimmed or otherwise secured without delay.
- 5 Wells, water tanks, drains, pits and similar facilities within the school premises shall be adequately protected and maintained in a safe condition. Protective covers, grills or nets provided for safety purposes shall be kept intact and serviceable at all times.

- 6 In the event of any structural distress, damage, leakage, cracks, settlement, deterioration or other defects arising due to ageing, weather conditions, natural calamities or any other cause, the affected portion of the building shall not be used until the necessary repairs and safety assessments have been completed by competent technical personnel.
- 7 Roofs covered with tiles, sheets or similar materials shall be inspected periodically, particularly during the rainy season and any defects or deficiencies detected shall be rectified promptly.
- 8 Kitchens, laboratories, storage areas and other special-purpose facilities shall be maintained separately and safely in accordance with the applicable rules and standards. Fire extinguishers and other emergency safety equipment shall be provided and maintained in readily accessible locations.
- 9 All doors, windows, staircases, handrails, gates and other building components shall be maintained in sound and serviceable condition to ensure the safe use of the building.
- 10 This certificate does not cover the safety of electrical installations, playground equipment, furniture, fire safety, LPG safety or any other facilities that have not been specifically examined as part of the structural inspection
- 11 Any new construction, addition, alteration, demolition work proposed within the school premises shall be undertaken only after obtaining the necessary approvals and permits from the Local Self Government Institution and other competent authorities. Adequate safety precautions, including barricading, warning signage, restricted access and supervision shall be ensured during the execution of such works.
- 12 The School Authority shall strictly comply with all the above conditions and shall ensure the continued safety of students, staff and visitors. Any deficiency observed during subsequent inspections shall be rectified forthwith. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in the withdrawal or cancellation of this Fitness Certificate and such other action as may be deemed necessary by the competent authority.
